

NOTICE OF RUN-OFF ELECTION

Pursuant to Section 15.3 of the Muscowpetung Saulteaux Nation Custom Election Act

Act - ... the Chief Electoral Officer shall set the date for and conduct a Run-Off Election not more than 30 days after the issuance of the decision,

WHEREAS in accordance with the *Muscowpetung Saulteaux Nation Custom Election Act* (the “Act”) and the decision of the Arbitrator issued on June 29, 2026, a **RUN-OFF ELECTION** will be held on the **30th of July**, to elect **one (1) individual to the office of the fifth Councillor position**

AND WHEREAS no nomination meeting is required for a run-off election pursuant to the Act;

AND WHEREAS the individuals named herein had met all the requirements of the Act to run in the previous Election held on April 3rd 2026;

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE AS FOLLOWS:

A. THAT the following individuals are the Candidates for the forthcoming run-off Election:

Candidates for 5th Councillor Position

THAT the Candidates will participate in two public forums at which the Candidates will make presentations and answer questions from the community. One forum will be held on Muscowpetung Saulteaux Nation Reserve No. 80, and one forum will be held in Regina, Saskatchewan, at the following times and places:

B. THAT the **Run-Off election** will be held on **July 30, 2026**, and eligible Electors may vote in the election by

- (i) attending the polling station,
- (ii) requesting a mail-in ballot, or
- (iii) participating in electronic balloting;

C. **THAT** Electors that wish to vote at the polling station must attend the polling station between the following times and at the following place:

Muscowpetung Polling Station	
Date:	July 30, 2026
Polls open:	9:00 am
Polls close:	8:00 pm
Poll location:	Education Center at Muscowpetung Saulteaux Nation
Bring with you:	Government-Issued Photo ID, such as a status card, drivers' license or passport

D. **THAT** According to the Act, 15 “(d) only those Electors who requested a mail-in ballot package in accordance with section 11.2 in the immediately preceding Election shall be entitled to receive a mail-in ballot package for the run-off election.”

E. **THAT** Electors that wish to vote by electronic ballot must (i) [pre-register](http://www.efdx.ca) at www.efdx.ca starting **Friday, July 24th at 9:00 A.M.** During registration you will be asked for personal identification and you will choose whether you want your ballot delivered by email or SMS text message. The Deputy Electoral Officer will verify all registration information, including your identity and eligibility for Virtual Voting. Electors may vote once they receive their confirmed ballot.

F. **THAT** Electors may obtain (i) a copy of the Voters List and (ii) a copy of the Act from the Chief Electoral Officer using the contact information at the bottom of this notice of election;

G. **THAT** for more information about the **Run-Off election**, you may contact the Chief Electoral Officer or Deputy Electoral Officer
